Please pay close attention to these procedures:-

- Sign-in for ALL Under 14s is on <u>Friday April 7</u> between 4.00 pm and 6.00 pm at the BARBADOS YACHT CLUB, BAY STREET, ST MICHAEL.
- Sign-in will close promptly at 6.00 pm.
- At Sign-in you are required to bring:
 - 1. Entry fee of **Bds \$100 (or US \$50)** in cash or a Bds cheque made payable to Barbados Tennis Association
 - 2. Valid passport
 - 3. Any outstanding Barbados Association subscriptions.- \$25 for 2017 (if member)
- 4. Any player competing in the U14 Division will be allowed to compete outside THE CITY WHERE HE/SHE RESIDES only if at the time of the mandatory sign in he/she names an adult as his/her legal guardian for the time the player is at the event. The legal guardian must attend the sign in and sign as responsible for the minor.
- Under 14 Round Robin will start on Sunday April 9 at the BARBADOS YACHT CLUB.
- Under 14 Main Draw will start following completion of the Under 14 Round Robin matches at the BARBADOS YACHT CLUB.
- The Order of Play for each day will be posted daily at the Tournament Hotel and tournament venues and on our **Website and Facebook page** see links below.
- Players are responsible for finding out when they have to play.
