- Sign-in for ALL Under 14s is on <u>Friday March 30</u> between 4.00 pm and 6.00 pm at the BARBADOS YACHT CLUB, BAY STREET, ST MICHAEL.
- Sign-in will close promptly at 6.00 pm.
- At Sign-in you are required to bring:
 - 1. Entry fee of <u>Bds \$100 (or US \$50)</u> in cash or a Bds cheque made payable to Barbados Tennis Association
 - 2. Valid passport
 - 3. Any outstanding Barbados Association subscriptions.- \$25 for 2018 (if member)
- Foreign resident players will not be allowed to sign in without a legal guardian present.

 Such players, at the time of the mandatory sign in, must name the adult who is his/her legal guardian for the time the player is at the event. The legal guardian must attend the sign in and sign as responsible for the minor.
- All players will participate the singles Round Robin followed by the knock-out Main or Consolation draw and the Doubles.
- Under 14 Round Robin will start on Saturday March 31 2018.
- Under 14 Main Draw & Consolidation Draw will start following completion of the Under 14 Round Robin matches.
- **Under 14 Doubles** Sign-in closes on Monday April 2 at 12.00 noon. Doubles teams must present themselves together, before that time, at the Referee's desk to sign-in.
- Players are responsible for finding out when they have to play.
- The Order of Play for each day will be posted daily at the tournament venue and on our <u>Website and Facebook page</u> – see links below.
- The Tournament is being played under ITF/COTECC Junior Regulations 2018. The ITF
 Junior Circuit Code of Conduct will apply and we expect all Players to observe the Code and
 not be cited for any Code Violations, which include conduct such as verbal abuse, ball
 abuse, racquet abuse, audible obscenities, visible obscenities, unsportsmanlike conduct,
 etc.
- The dress code will be strictly enforced.
- A new "no let" rule has been introduced into the regulations.

Practice courts

Practice courts will be available for reservation at the Tournament Desk(s) without charge as follows:-

Barbados Yacht Club (BYC) 7am to Start of play Daily

National Tennis Centre (NTC) 8am to 2pm Saturday to Wednesday

Courts can only be reserved for half hour intervals on a priority basis.

Transport
